Symptoms of a strep A infection

- flu-like symptoms, such as a high temperature, swollen glands or an aching body.
- sore throat (strep throat or tonsillitis)
- a rash that feels rough, like sandpaper (scarlet fever)
- scabs and sores (impetigo)
- pain and swelling (cellulitis)
- severe muscle aches.
- nausea and vomiting.
