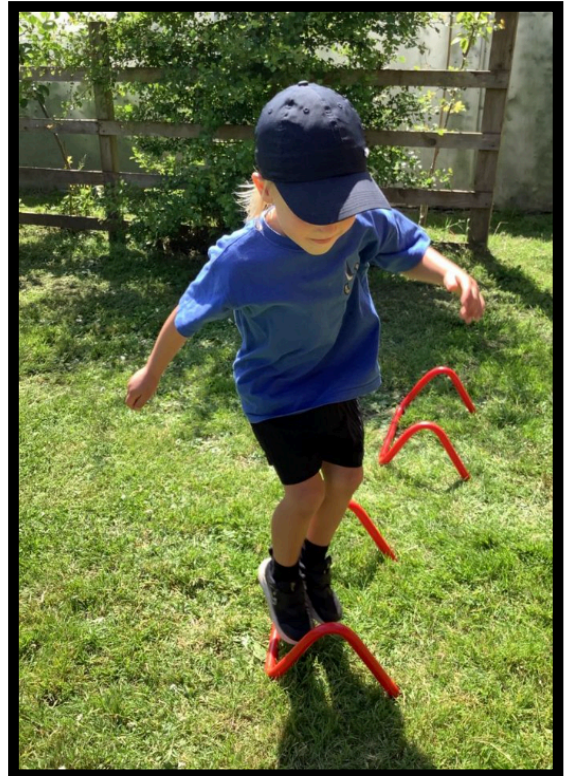


Head teachers award to all who participated with such joy and confidence in our sports day-this also includes all the enthusiastic parents who took part in the relay race!
