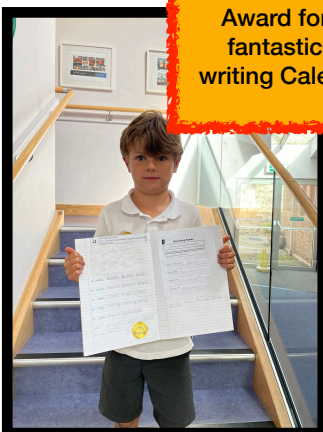
Please ensure that your children has a water bottle, healthy snack, coat, and sun hat.
