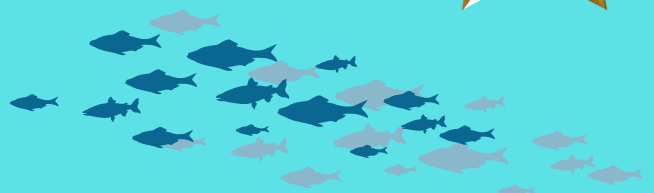
## Stars of the week

Samson- for settling into Mousehole Mice really well. making new friends and always being kind and helpful.

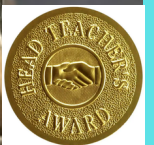
