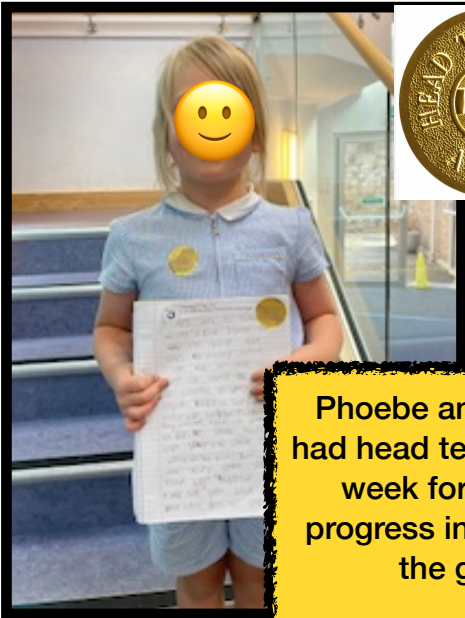
Great way to end the session with a mixed game against Sennen. The children played brilliantly and the score was 2:2. Well done to you all.

Send a message via ChatHealth (anonymously if you like) to our Health Visiting and School Nursing teams to get confidential help and advice about a range of health matters.

ChatHealth is available Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) from 9am to 5pm. When you send a message to any of the ChatHealth numbers, you'll get an automated reply to let you know your message has been received. A trained healthcare professional will reply to you during office hours, and within 48 hrs.
