

<u>Intent</u>

The intent of Mousehole Primary School's art and design curriculum is to provide a high quality curriculum that builds on children's early creative experiences. Our curriculum develops creativity, sets challenges, engages and inspires children. It also equips them with the knowledge and skill to experiment, invent and create works of art, craft and design. Children are given the skills to think critically of their own and others work and are given the time to gain an understanding of each area of art and design through a planned sequence of lessons. To provide them with a respectful, natural inquisitiveness and appreciation of art in all of its forms. We believe that it is very important for children to have an understanding of how art and design has contributed to our culture and other cultures and also how it has shaped history and the world. Through this concept children will explore a variety of both local and world-renowned artists and their styles.

At Mousehole we believe that art plays a critical factor in the development of pupils' wellbeing. Giving children the confidence and space to express themselves through a variety of mediums aids in developing confident learners who are happy and willing to give things a go.

Implementation

~ To ensure children learn about artists and designers that have influenced culture and history in Cornwall, Britain and throughout the world.
