We hope you have a lovely weekend and look forward to seeing you at the Christmas Fair on Monday!

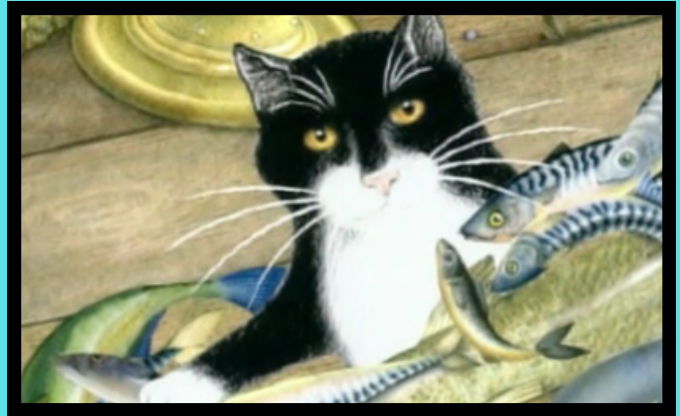

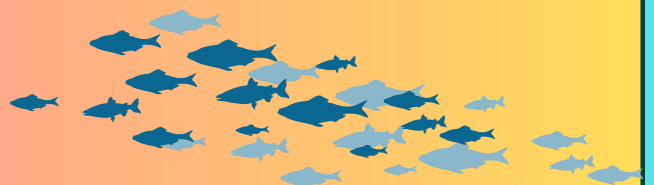

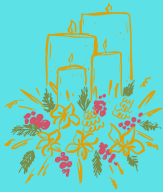
