



Results:

Attainment

Below you can find the detail of recent year's year 6 cohort's academic achievement, attainment and progress. At present the end of Key Stage 2 results are measured by Summative Assessments Tests (SATs) set by the National Curriculum Authority. The results are based on one cohort's performance. Mousehole school has small cohorts. Our pupil admission number is 15 so each child is worth 6.6% and if we have a cohort with above average Special Educational Needs or with children who have only joined the school in the last one or two years it can skew the data dramatically. The Cornwall and national averages for 2015 are included for comparison.
